




Stacked FLOOR TO CEILING!!! EVERYWHERE!!!!




And EVEN MORE Radios!!!! Its MADNESS!!

Eat your heart out!!!




HOLY GRAIL FOUND!!! This is a Polycomm 2 in Mint Condx, VERY TNX to W6EKR!!!!




I could PAY OFF MY MORTGAGE if I ever put these 2 on EBAY!!

Plenty of drawers for Parts




INCREDIBLY RARE 1920s Crystal Set

Here's something you'd NEVER expect to see in a house! This is a Door to a Dodge Van, complete with WW2 style Nose art!




Besides Old Radios, there are plenty of computers! 12 Active networked Windows 98SE PCs throughout the estate.
